A Love That Draws**Bible Study**

We are in a time when free love is not exactly free and it doesn't seem to draw us either. We are expected to repay tenfold that which has been given to us. Life with Jesus is not so! That type of mentality is not to be tolerated nor counted among us especially when it comes to extending our love to the sole purpose of drawing people to Jesus.

God drew us to Himself with a merciful love until our time was fulfilled to become a follower of Jesus then He established a covenant love with us and expects us to draw people to him using the same types of love. Come with me and see what God has to teach us in His Word today.

Using the Word for Love

The Bible shows us God's love from beginning to end. We are bombarded with it but it never looks the same from verse to verse. Why doesn't it look the same? People are not the same and He loves them for different reasons and loves them into doing what they were born to do. There was covenant born in the Old Testament but not like our covenant today and there was mercy in the Old Testament too but not like it is today.

The Word of God is the great love book ever written. It defines love better than any book I have read. There is a small problem with this book!

1 Cor 1:18

1 Peter 2:4-10

2 Tim 3:16

The Bible is a book of commandments for the believer, which we are to use to love our brethren, but since it is a stumbling block for the unbeliever there is only one way we can love them to draw them to Jesus, a merciful love!

Covenant Love for our Brethren

A covenant is much like a legal agreement between two parties whom are both expected to hold up to their end of the agreement. Covenant love is the same and the reason we remain in this covenant love is LOVE ironically enough. The OT speaks of covenants with people but their main objective was obedience whereas in the NT the covenant with us IS love.

We have these common verses (Matthew 22:37-39, Mark 12:30-31, Luke 10:27) but the commandment that causes us to be in Covenant Love with our Brethren is John 13:35. Let us discuss the difference between them while bringing in this story. Luke 10:27-37

A Love That Draws**Bible Study**

What does this covenant love with the brethren look like according to Scripture?

1 John 3:11-18, Romans 12:10, Luke 17:3, 1 Timothy 5:20, Galatians 6:1

We are required by Jesus to love each other as He has loved us. This is a covenant love that is intended to encourage and edify our brethren to continue to help them draw closer to Jesus. It is not a fluffy love that allows our brethren to continue acting as enemies of God. It is a love that teaches, rebuke, corrects and trains in the truth of Jesus Christ and also causes them to have a merciful love for the unbeliever.

Merciful Love for Unbelievers

The Jews were not required to show mercy to those God hadn't chosen and over time the Jews did not even show mercy to their own people. Fast forward to today. God's mercy is for His chosen just as His grace is also for them. Mercy is the withholding of God's wrath! Jesus took all this wrath for us on the cross so that who so ever should believe will not be condemned.

Is God's mercy still confined to His chosen people? Yes or No!

Who then can show this mercy to unbelievers? 2 Corinthians 1:3-4

The believer gives the Merciful Love to the unbeliever so what does Jesus tell us that looks like?
Luke 6:27-33

We are required to show God's Merciful Love to the unbeliever to draw them to Jesus and to show them what God's mercy looks like! If we show mercy to the condemned then we will continue to receive that same mercy from God.

We are under a covenant love with the brethren and a mercy love with the unbeliever how then should we love those who profess to be Christians yet live like the world?

Coercive Love for the “Christian”

The “Christian” inside the quotes is someone who sits in our gatherings or are in our life professing to be a Christian yet living like the enemy of God. Let us consider these folks because they are the ones who perplex us the most. They are on their way to Jesus but somehow get stalled or stopped altogether. We saw through the Word that we need to rebuke those Christians who are in sin and we are to treat the unbeliever with mercy but these folks are different! They know of the mercy, grace and love available to them with Jesus yet they refuse it! Are we under a covenant love with them or a merciful love with them? Tell me why?

We are under a covenant love with them because they profess to be a Christian although when we discover that they are not we will revert to a merciful love to attempt to draw them to Jesus or back to Jesus.

Action Plan for US

We want to make sure that we recognize who we should love and in what manner. Let us read Galatians 5:16-25

What is it that these people all need that we have to give away?

Change your definition of Love over the next two months. We have been told what love is but we are not to live by what we are told by humans we are to live by what Jesus tells us! Jesus turned the status quo upside down and that is exactly what He expects us to do.

Test out this newly defined covenant love on your brethren and extend this newly defined merciful love on the unsaved! For the next two months seek out the ones you despise (the unsaved and the saved) and commit yourself to loving them with a covenant love and a merciful love. Document how it changes you and make note of how it changes them. Remember that in doing this for people who dislike you or hate you, you will heap coals on their head (Proverbs 25:22) and the Lord will reward you but the biggest reward will be here on earth as you see yourself change into what Jesus intended you to be!
